KMCT College of Pharmacy is established in the year 2020 at Mampara, Pazhur-P.O, Kuttippuram, Malappuram district, Kerala. B.Pharm course is approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) and affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS). D.Pharm course is also approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) & All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). The college is run by Kunhitharuvai Memorial Charitable Trust (KMCT). 1. Introduction

- 1.1 This Prospectus contains rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission to the Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) course at KMCT College of Pharmacy at Mampara, Pazhur-P.O, Kuttippuram against sanctioned intake for the academic year 2024-25,
- 1.2 This prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the college and subject to the Judgments of Hon'ble Courts of law

2. Number of seats and details of reservation

- 2.1 B. Pharm course is approved with an intake of 60 seats. Out of the above, 30 seats will be filled up by the management and remaining 30 seats is willing to share for the allotment by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Government of Kerala as per the reservation policy of the Government.
- 2.2 Out of the 30 seats earmarked for management quota, 60% (18 seats) seats will be filled up by the applicants belonging to Muslim minority category as the institution have applied for minority status. The remaining 40% (12 seats) seats will be filled up in the order of merit from the applicants.
- 2.3 The details of reservation of seats are as follows

	Category of reservation	Number of seats
1	Management Quota	
a.	General Merit	12

If sufficient candidates are not available in the Muslim minority category, such seats will be filled up by the candidates from General merit.

If the Government is not willing to conduct allotment to the Government quota, those seats will be filled up as the management quota by following the reservation policy mentioned in the above table.

The college has submitted application for increase of intake and the application is under process in the statutory bodies. If the permission is obtained for increase of seats the seat matrix and reservation will be changed proportionately.

3. Eligibility for Admission

3.1 Academic:

Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Biology/Mathematics separately and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Mathematics put together are eligible.

NB : However candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from outside the state of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of qualifying examination from Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of admission. Eligibility for admission to the candidates belonging to OBC, OEC, SC/ST will be as per the requirements of the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. .

3.2 Age

Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on 31/12/2024

No upper age limit for B. Pharm course.

5. How to Apply.

5.1 Application for admission to B. Pharm course can be submitted only through online. The provision for online application is available at the website www.kmctcollegeofpharmacy.org. Prospectus can also be downloaded from the above website.

The application form and prospectus will not be available by post and submission of more than one application by a candidate will lead to rejection of candidature.

The candidate can register their application by entering the details of the candidate, marks and uploading of the qualifying examination mark list, photo and signature as

specified in the online application portal. The last date for submission of application is mentioned in the schedule of admission process (clause 12).

5.2 Application Fee:

- (i) The application fee will be Rs.1000/- for all candidates, payable through UPI/online banking to the account number of the college provided in the application portal.
- (ii) After registration of the application the applicant can remit the application fee through UPI/online banking to the account number of the college provided in the online application portal. The UPI reference number/Online banking UTR number can be entered in the field provided in the online application portal
- (iii) Submission of application will be completed only after entering the details of the payment of application fee in the online application portal.
- (iv) If the payment is debited and you are not guided to the second stage please inform us to help@kmctcollegeofpharmacy.org with your Name, email-id and mobile number, we will provide you the required help within 24Hrs.
- (v) Application fee once remitted will not be refunded in any circumstances.

5.3 The candidates can get the instructions to make the payment and submission of application form in the link “Admission” on the website www.kmctcollegeofpharmacy.org. No need of submission of hardcopy of application

6. Selection of candidates

6.1 Admissions will be done on the basis of marks obtained in the relevant subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics) by the candidates in qualifying examination. The marks obtained by the candidates in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various Boards or authority of other states shall be equated with the marks obtained by the candidates in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the Director of HSE, Kerala. Marks obtained by the candidates under various streams of examinations such as HSE in Kerala/CBSE/ICSE etc. will be subject to the process of normalization.

Explanation: Under the method of normalization, the highest mark obtained by students of various Boards in each subject shall be equated to the highest mark obtained by the students of the Kerala Higher Secondary examination in that subject and the relative marks obtained by other students in that subject shall be determined accordingly.

Illustration: If the highest marks secured by the student of the Kerala state HSE, in Physics is 100 and the highest mark secured by a student on any other board in the same subject is 90, both the highest marks will be considered to be equal to 100, if a student of the other board secures 60 marks in Physics when the highest mark in

Physics in the same board is 90, the 60 marks will be considered to be equal to 66.67marks as arrived at below:

$$100 \times 60 / 90 = 66.66\%$$

Those candidates, who have passed the qualifying examination of any state other than Kerala, will be treated at par with those students who have passed the Higher Secondary Exam of this state. Since the normalized marks depend on the applications of a college, the index marks of an applicant may vary from college to college.

7. Preparation of Rank List

7.1 The Rank list will be published by the college in its website www.kmctcollegeofpharmacy.org.

i In case of a tie in the total marks, the marks in Chemistry in the qualifying examination will be counted. If there is still a tie, the marks in physics will be counted. If a tie still exists, the age of the candidate will be taken into account, the elder preferred to the younger. If a tie again exists, the alphabetical ascending order of the name of the candidates in English will be taken in to account.

ii Furnishing false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

iii Seats lying vacant after the date fixed for the completion of admission will be treated as lapsed seats and can be filled up by the respective Colleges from among the application received from the eligible candidates.

7.2 Muslim minority Quota: The selection of candidates to Muslim minority community will be based on the rank list prepared by the college from among the applicants belonging to minority category. Such candidates should submit community certificate from the revenue authorities at the time of admission

7.3 All right of claim for eligibility relaxation or community claim shall be sustained with the required documents to prove the community at the time of admission.

8. Allotment of eligible candidates

8.1 Eligible candidates from the rank list will be allotted for admission as per the reservation policy mentioned in clause 2.3 and such candidates will be informed through email provided in their application

8.2 The date of allotment is mentioned in the schedule of admission process (clause 12)

9. Admission & Payment of Fees

- 9.1 The allotment memo will be sent to the selected candidates through email provided in their application
- 9.2 The students should report at the college along with the following documents and first year fee as mentioned in the clause 4 of this prospectus
- 9.3 All the students should stay in the hostel.

- Allotment Memo
- Aadhar card or any other identity proof as provided in the application.
- Mark list of the candidate at the qualifying examination.
- Pass Certificate of the candidate at the qualifying examination.
- SSLC
- Document (School Record, SSLC or equivalent) of the candidate to prove his/ her date of birth.
- Eligibility/equivalency certificate obtained from the Kerala University of Health Sciences by candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala / CBSE / ISCE.
- A Physical Fitness Certificate in the prescribed format obtained from a Medical Officer in Government Service not below the rank of Assistant Medical Officer.
- Course and conduct certificate from the institution last attended.
- Transfer certificate (TC) from the institution last attended.
- Document/ certificate required in proof of any benefit claimed in the application for reservation.

Selected candidates have to remit all the first year fees as mentioned in the clause 4 of this prospectus at the time of admission itself. The fee can be paid by RTGS/NEFT/DD/Net banking/Online banking to the college account. If the entire first year fee as mentioned above is not remitted within the time of admission, the application of the candidate will be removed from the admission process.

- 9.4 If any candidate discontinues the course, after closing of admission as notified by the authority, the candidate has to pay the full fee of the remaining course (4 yrs). The Collection of liquidated damages shall be as per the final decision of the AFRC or Court of Law.
- 9.5 All the students should pay their fees for the subsequent years on or before 31st August of the respective years

10. Special Instructions.

- (i) Ragging: Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in all member colleges. All the member colleges are committed to abolish ragging in their campuses. Hence any student who indulges in any form of ragging will be subjected to penal action as per provisions of law. Also, the student will be expelled from the college as detailed in the law concerned and as per Honorable Supreme Court of India directions in this regard

- (ii) Use of Mobile Phone: Use of Mobile Phone by students are not allowed in the campuses and hostels of any member colleges of association. Any violation of this prohibition will lead to stringent disciplinary action by the college authorities.
- (iii) Any other items not specifically covered in this prospectus will be decided by the Controller of admission.

11. Undertaking regarding non-involvement in ragging

Each candidate and parent has to sign the undertaking given below at the time of admission (as per the provisions of anti-ragging verdict by the Honorable Supreme Court).
